

Clinical Advisor/Coordinator

Mind HK is a fast-paced, quickly-growing mental health charity, with the mission to ensure that no one in Hong Kong is facing a mental health problem alone. Since our launch in November 2017, we have trained over 13,000 people on mental health awareness, have an average of 50,000 users per month on our website, and regularly engage with hundreds of thousands of individuals from the local community through our campaigns.

Mind HK is currently seeking a bilingual, part-time Clinical Advisor/Coordinator, who can contribute to various duties within the organisation.

The role will support the development of mental health resources, training, and website, social media, and campaign content, all of which will reach thousands in Hong Kong. This role will also advise on the design, development and implementation of Mind HK's programmes, and conduct training sessions on mental health related topics. They will also help with the content development and review for Mind HK's online virtual assistant "Help Me", which seeks to provide easy-access mental health information to Hong Kong.

The successful candidate will work closely with the training, digital, communications, and clinical advisory team and will have an opportunity to work with a range of staff, who hold different expertise, in a range of external-focused projects. This role does not involve providing frontline clinical support. Other ad-hoc, clinical related tasks will be required based on projects' needs.

Requirements

- Qualification in mental health (Masters or higher qualification in a mental health related topic) e.g. Masters in Clinical Psychology, Masters of Social Sciences (Mental Health), Masters in Counselling, Masters in Mental Health Nursing
- Comprehensive understanding of mental health and mental health conditions
- Good written and communication skills
- Fluent in English and Cantonese (spoken and written)
- Comfortable public speaking and providing training
- Passion for increasing mental health awareness and reducing stigma in the community

Desirable

- Clinical experience in providing mental health services
- Knowledge of ACT and CBT
- Management/coordination experience
- NGO and/or health promotion experience
- Tech savvy
